## DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

U.S. Building Inspectors will not share personal information. We only share Customer personal information after receiving express consent. Customers may opt out of U.S. Building Inspectors sharing this information with such third parties at any time Additionally, we may disclose your information:

 To our services providers, contractors, and third parties we use to support our business, such as those providing IT security, analysis of usage data, and other

- services to provide our products and services. However, such parties are only authorized to use the information as directed with your written consent.
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of U.S. Building Inspectors' assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which information held by U.S. Building Inspectors about our Website users is among the assets transferred.
